



ZeSight Privacy Policy

The Clinician is committed to providing secure IT services while protecting the privacy of individuals and organisations it serves to a very high standard and ensures maximum protection for confidential information. This document describes the key principles that relate to privacy, ownership and secondary use of collected data within the scope of a collaboration with The Clinician.

We collect personal information from you, including your:

- name
- contact information
- information related with health, travel and contact with others
- interactions with us
- automatically collected data (e.g. IP number, cookies, pixel tags etc.)
- billing or purchase information

We collect your personal information in order to monitor the health status of individuals to keep them and others safe during a disease outbreak or other threats for health and safety.

After deidentification (e.g. removing personally identifiable information (PII) such as name, contact details etc.) we may share this information with your employer and healthcare providers in order to provide them with critical information for risk assessment and management of the problem. Under extreme circumstances, a *break the glass* functionality is available to share your personal information when this information is deemed critical for your or others' safety. Under this scheme, all details of such access (including reasons) is logged and made available to you on request.

Providing some information is optional. If you choose not to enter accurate and complete information, we may be unable to provide you and others the most appropriate guidance.

We keep your information safe by using industry standard encryption for storing and transmitting this information and making this available to only authorised users .



We keep your information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. Afterwards we securely destroy it by physically erasing all digital and any print copies.

Ultimate ownership of your information belongs to you and the role of The Clinician is one of data stewardship. Under this scheme, The Clinician will not use your information for purposes other than providing services; however descriptive statistics and aggregate anonymised information may be used to improve service quality and shared with other clients for benchmarking.

You have the right to ask for a copy of any personal information we hold about you, and to ask for it to be corrected if you think it is wrong.
